The UNESCO WWAP Water Rooms Project (2015) consists of a visionary and inspirational itinerary of 5 short animated movies intertwined by 5 monologues that trigger interest and encourage learning about freshwater resources and their responsible and sustainable management. The Water Rooms were launched in 2015 at the Milan Universal Exposition (EXPO 2015).

The second edition of the UNESCO WWAP Water Rooms 2.0 (2018-2020) will promote research, knowledge sharing and education on freshwater, enriching the original 2015 Project with new videos, educational tools, dissemination and outreach activities.

The Water Rooms Project 2.0 ultimate goal is improving participatory governance processes, promoting sustainable and equitable use of water resources, flood preparedness and resilience measures.
